Monday 9 <sup>th</sup> July	Year 8	Manchester Science and Industry Museum	£6.50	<p>Science Trip: The Museum of Science and Industry has a programme of interactive shows, workshops and other learning activities. We want pupils to discover the story of where science met industry and the modern world began, from steam power and the cotton industry, to computing and cutting-edge scientific research.</p> <p>We want to make it clear how Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths play a vital role in day to day life.</p> <p>Pupils will be required to wear school uniform and take a packed lunch with them. There is a gift shop but please bring no more than £15 to spend. The children will be back by normal end of day.</p>
