FREE SCHOOL MEALS - Very important information . Unfortunately this is not for children receiving universal free school meals.

Dear parents,

We are working with Aspens our caterers to organise free school meals for pick ups on Monday 30th March . We are assured that the food package will be more substantial than last week. They will also contain a voucher for STANS supermarket to enable families to purchase food for the two weeks after Easter.

Therefore, this will be the last food packages for 5 weeks.

This voucher is to provide food for the 2 weeks after the Easter holidays April the 6th - 10th and 13th -17th. After which we think the government will introduce a national voucher scheme. Please keep in touch with the website for more details.

If you wish to have food packages and STANS vouchers (£23 per child), you must collect from either school or the collection points in the villages and Oswestry.

Vouchers will need to be signed out by staff and therefore we will be undertaking very

carefully social distancing measures to protect everyone.

- 1. Please be patient and if there is a queue leave at least 2m (6ft) spaces between yourselves other people picking up and school staff. We are not being rude just following Government rules.
- 2. There will be one bag for each student containing food and one voucher (families with more than one child take more than one bag and give dates of birth of kids to school staff)
- 3. We may not be able to post vouchers or keep food in school.
- 4. If your family is self isolating please try to arrange for a friend to pick up for you. (they will need to know **Dates of Birth of children**)
- 5. If you have filled in and returned the medical or dietary requirements form (below) ensure staff are aware as your package may have different contents.
- 6. Work with us to make this as safe and respectful as possible.
