Dear parents/carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming your child into Reception in September 2022. This year we have had an increase in the number of children wishing to attend our school and we are delighted to let you know that from September we will have two Reception classes.

Both classes will work alongside each other and class-teachers will work together to plan and support the children throughout the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage). We are currently working out classes and timetables and we will write to you soon to let you know who your child's class-teacher will be.

In the mean-time we will be holding two New Parents Meetings. One on **Tuesday 21**<sup>st</sup> **June at 9.15 a.m.** and the other on **Wednesday 22**<sup>nd</sup> **June at 3.30 p.m.** to share information about school life and the daily routine. This will be an opportunity for you to meet the teachers and ask any questions you may have about your child starting school.

NB: Please note that you will only need to attend one of these meetings.

If you are unable to attend either of these meetings we will be able to send you a copy of the presentation.

**MOVE UP MORNING – Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June** This is for your child to come and spend a morning with their new Reception class-teacher.

We are also planning to have some extra transition sessions for those children not currently attending our Nursery. These will take place on a Thursday afternoon from 1.00pm – 2.55pm in our Nursery so they get a chance to meet some of the children they will be with in September. Dates of these will be emailed out to you.

In addition to this we are going to arrange to visit the children in their current setting (if they attend one) so that we can start to get to know them.
