Congratulations to Demi Moreton who won the house competition to design a time machine, its still on show in the school reception and is very impressive!

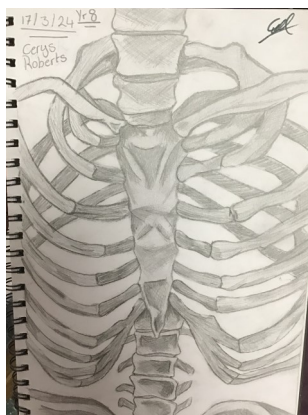
