
Special Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) vaccination session—note from shropshire health team

Measles is a serious illness – it's highly contagious and can lead to complications. There are a high number of cases in Birmingham and given the close links between Birmingham and Shropshire there is a possibility we will have outbreaks in Shropshire schools soon too. The School Aged Immunisation Service are holding an MMR vaccination clinic (booked appointments only) on the morning of Saturday 27th April 2024 at Cambrian Surgery, Thomas Savin Rd, Oswestry **SY11 1GA** to offer the MMR vaccine to our pupils, siblings and parents, If you are unsure if your child is up to date with routine vaccinations, check your child's Red Book (personal child health record) or you can contact your GP practice to check. If you would like your child, siblings or indeed yourself to have the vaccination please contact the School Aged Immunisation Service on 01743 730028 or email shropcom.immunisationteam@nhs.net to book an appointment.

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Just a reminder to parents about our enhanced procedures for mobile phones in school. Students from year 7-11 can bring a phone to school but this must be left switched off and in their school bag from when the arrive at school until the end of the day. If phones are seen they will be confiscated and a parent or nominated adult will need to come to school to collect it. Year 6 phones need to be handed into the class teacher until the end of the day.
