Dear Parents/Carers,

We are fortunate to have a high number on roll within the primary phase for September 2024.

Our year groups range in size considerably from 18 to 42. It is because of this that in September we will be organising our classes differently into seven classes rather than eight.

At the end of the Summer Term, Miss Fiddy will be leaving. She has an exciting opportunity to work at a school closer to home. We all wish her every success with this.
