Please congratulate the y9 boys rugby team. Only 8 boys could play!

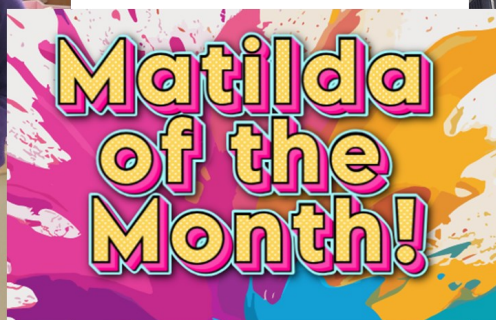
They played Grove School and Oswestry School, sadly losing to them both but scored tries in both matches.
