



Remote learning offer at St Martins school

Microsoft teams

“Teams” is an integral part of our learning journey. Students have their own Microsoft 365 account which not only gives them access to their school email but also their documents (on their SharePoint) and access to their Teams account.

Each class a student takes has its own designated ‘Team’ on Microsoft Teams. Students are automatically added to their class teams at the start of each academic year. These teams are run by the class teacher and they will regularly post key information about the course on the teams ‘channel’ for example clips which might be of interest following a lesson or articles to read which further students understanding of their learning in school that day. Each team also has access to a folder called ‘resources’ and ‘class materials’ here teachers will have uploaded Golden Knowledge for topics, core questions, knowledge organisers and where appropriate revision materials such as subject checklists and countdown to exams resources.

Teaching staff also use Teams to set home learning assignments and CID projects at KS3. Students will be notified when an assignment has been set when they log into Teams and guardians will also be informed when assignments have been set through the home learning app Haldor.

Edclass

Edclass is an online learning platform where students can access live lessons and recorded lessons from KS2 to GCSE in all subjects. At St Martin's school we use Edclass with students on Alternative programmes, with students who for many reasons are struggling to attend school. Edclass can be monitored and supported by staff in school when students are working from home.

We also use Edclass in our “reset and restart” department to support learning when a student cannot access their normal lessons.
