
SAFETY UPDATE


- No asbestos present in the areas damaged by the fire.
- Areas affected boarded up to prevent access
- Structural safety assessment
- Reconnection of main utilities
- Reconnection and testing of fire alarm system
- Industrial level cleaning and air quality testing

SITE DEVELOPMENTS

Areas lost:

- dining area, staff and Year9-11 toilets, main school water tank, main school hall, Hub/reception area, Music classroom.
- On site we now have temporary
 accommodation to replace these but they
 need utilities and fire alarms running to
 them this is currently underway.
- There is a real issue with water pressure on site, we have engineers looking for a solution for us.
- Main hall and hub area are secured and out of bounds
- Bungalow is now the temporary reception area until the Hub area is renovated.









RE-OPENING TIMELINE

- 1. This depends on all internal work completed on the temporary buildings.
- 2. A solution to the water pressure problem as this directly affects water for toilets, handwashing and some subject e.g. Science.
- 3. Re-writing procedures and health and safety processes e.g. fire evacuation
- 4. Aiming for first week after half term.

RE-OPENING TIMELINE

- 1. Year 11 there is no College provision week commencing 3rd November.
- 2. If we are not fully open, we will continue with face-to-face rotation of teaching on site, alongside online learning and add Year 11 to onsite provision.
- 3. Frequency of live lessons/online learning.
- 4. If we re-open, we will stagger the start so pupils can adjust to being back in school and we can spend time with them explaining new processes and procedures.

Academic Catch up

- How much catch up needed will depend on how much online learning they have been able to complete
- Teachers and Heads of Department have a clear overview of who has and hasn't engaged.
- If your child is struggling to access work due to SEND needs, please let us know.
- Consolidation lessons will happen on year groups' return.
- We are looking at a plan for the end of the academic year which uses staff time when Year 10 have completed their MFL exams.

Academic Catch up

- Moving the mocks to Spring Term allows for catch up with Year 11.
- Maths and other core subjects have already been assessing gaps in knowledge during their college days.
- Extra staffing has been added to Maths for the end of the autumn term to concentrate on catch up.
- After school revision sessions on a Tuesday will recommence with year 11.
- There are already after school sessions in place for some academic area e.g.
 Art
- Work/catch up will be placed on Teams. Departments will provide sessions where they feel catch up is needed.

- 1. Tutor important they are at school for tutor time when we return
